The Royal Canadian Legion was formed on November 25, 1925 and has supported veterans, the RCMP and their families since its inception.

Branch 554, spearheaded by Rev. Robert Merritt has begun the task of remembering these brave men who perished during WW1, WW2 and since.

It is our desire to produce banners with the soldiers, picture, rank and date of death. These banners would be suspended from the light standards that line Laurier Avenue so we may remember those that bravely fought and perished so we may live free.

Rev. Merritt's research has uncovered 14 names of soldiers from Rockland since it was formed in 1868 by the Edward's family.

With the support of Mayor Guy Desjardins and Councillor Carl Grimard we are reaching out to the community in hopes of finding additional names and pictures of these soldiers. We want to make sure all these soldiers are included and solicit your help to make sure this happens.
